### PARADE SAFETY RULES & REGULATIONS

1. No fire, open flame, or flame effects are permitted in the parade. None.
2. Alcohol is not permitted in the parade or in any parade vehicles, including art cars and floats, or anywhere throughout the event except in the official Festival Beer Garden in Civic Center Park.
3. Due to safety concerns on behalf of the City of Berkeley, parade participants cannot throw, toss, or otherwise distribute candy or other objects from a moving vehicle. Anything distributed to the parade audience must be hand distributed by parade participants walking along the parade route, away from moving vehicles.
4. Parade Participants agree to a pre-parade inspection of any vehicle or group for the sole purpose of meeting these safety conditions.
5. "How Berkeley Can You Be!?" staff, including all organizers, Epic Arts staff, and volunteers, reserve the right to remove any vehicle, group, or individual from the parade that does not meet these safety criteria.
